Tournament Regulations

This is your opportunity to play in the Riverside Youth Open 2010 at the Riverside Pool Club, to compete for a share in the £1000+ prize fund and trophies (**subject to entries**).

Entry: £10 per person for Under 16, £15 for Under 18 and £20 for Under 21. Closing date for entry is Sunday 18th April 2010. Entry forms to be sent, with a cheque/postal order, made payable to; Neil Toms, to the address above.

Age Limit: All entrants will need to be aged under 16, 18 or 21 respectively on the date of the competition. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone they feel may be overage so *entrants are advised to bring some form of identification with them on the day* to avoid disappointment.

Rules: Played to World 8-ball Pool Rules, U16 best of 7 frames, U18 best of 9 frames, U21 best of 11 frames.

Draw: Draw for the event will be completed on Sunday 18th April and will be posted on www.riversidepoolclub.com with the scheduled start times.

Play: Play will commence at 11:00am on both days, with scheduled start times and the event being played down to a winner on the day.
